Former Judge Disbarred

A former state Appeals Court judge has agreed to be disbarred after pleading guilty to stealing from the trust fund he managed for a mentally disabled woman.

Roland Amundson will be sentenced next month on five counts of felony theft by swindle. He waived his right to a hearing on his disbarment.

The Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility had filed papers on the case with the state Supreme Court, which will make the final decision on the disbarment.

Amundson resigned from the bench in March. He pleaded guilty April first to stealing more than \$300,000.

He has said he was undergoing treatment for depression, and that he didn't need the money. He has agreed to repay all of it.
