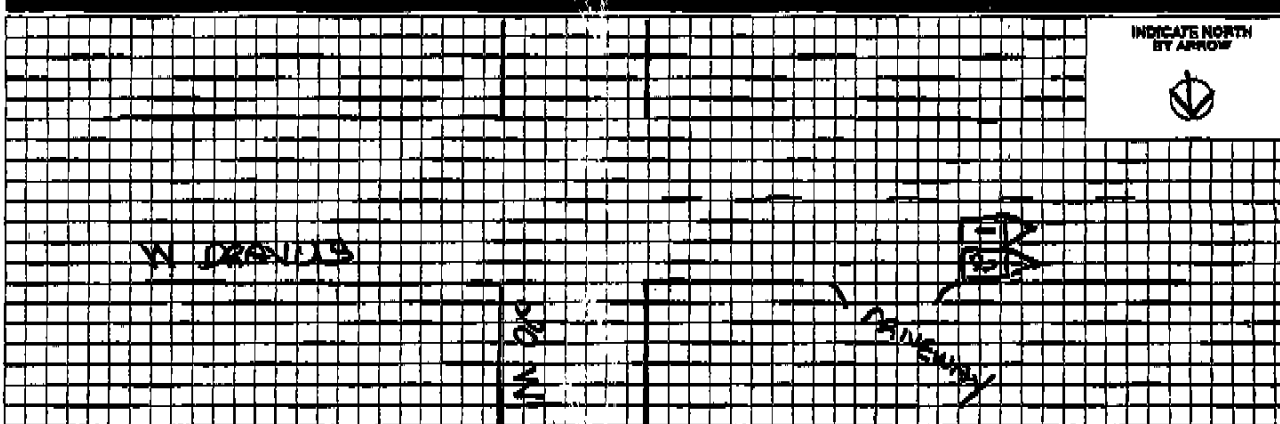

Incident Narrative

On 02-28-03 I was in uniform in a marked DUI patrol car in the City of Seattle. I responded to 28 Av W and W Dravus St., where it was reported that a vehicle, license [redacted], had hit a parked vehicle and left the scene. Complainant had the driver, S/Bridge, pinned in waiting for police to arrive. Complainant indicated, to 911, that the driver was possibly intoxicated. Ofc. Andrews (3Q1) and Sgt. Yamanaka (3Q) responded to the scene and contacted the parties involved.

When I arrived Ofc. Andrews told me that S/Bridge was possibly intoxicated. I contacted S/Bridge who was still seated in the driver's seat of her vehicle. S/Bridge's eyes were very red and watery. S/Bridge told me [redacted] S/Bridge had a strong odor of alcohol on her breath. S/Bridge's speech was slurred and her movements were slow and deliberate. S/Bridge told me [redacted] I observed damage to the passenger side mirror. Ofc. Michl advised me that the right front tire was flat. I asked S/Bridge if she stopped, after hitting the vehicle, and left her information. S/Bridge said [redacted]

I asked S/Bridge if she would be willing to perform a series of voluntary Field Sobriety Tests (FST's). [redacted]

period. S/Bridge was under my constant observation during the 15 minute observation period and throughout the administration of the breath test. [REDACTED] conducted the breath test and the results were .219 and .227 BrAC.

I gave S/Bridge a copy of her breath test results and her Notice of Right to Hearing. I cited S/Bridge for DUI (CI #10227361) and Ofc. Andrews cited S/Bridge for Hit & Run (CI #10227362). Ofc. Michl and I transported S/Bridge to her residence at [REDACTED] where she was released.

Sgt. Yamazaki had contacted [REDACTED] at the scene. [REDACTED] showed Sgt. Yamazaki where S/Bridge had hit the parked unoccupied vehicle. Sgt. Yamazaki obtained a written statement from [REDACTED].
